He plays Hawaiian, hapa haole, contemporary, and his own original songs with great passion and verve. Whether playing for an intimate wedding ceremony or a festival audience, his performances are both exhilarating and inspiring. He accompanies his moving vocals with adroit musicianship on 'ukulele, slack key guitar, and keyboards.

Anthony has released two albums: His debut EP called "Never Letting Go" featuring Uncle George Kahumoku Jr., and "Singing to the World: Maui Mele Pana." He is one of the Aloha ambassadors for the Lei of Aloha and has released a single of his "Ku'u Lei Aloha," the first of two songs he's written to accompany the Lei of Aloha on its various journeys of healing around the world.
